

SPEED CUPS

Game Instruction

Playing with

Players: 2-4

Age: 5-up

The Game Contains

20 Cups (4 sets of 5 colors each), 24 picture cards and one bell.

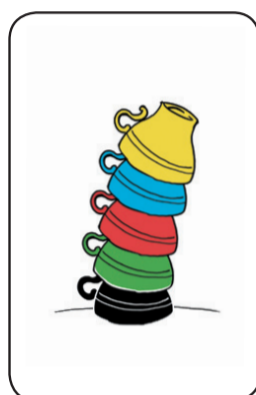
The Object of the Game

To be the first to arrange your cups in the right color sequence as shown on the card.

Horizontal card



Vertical card

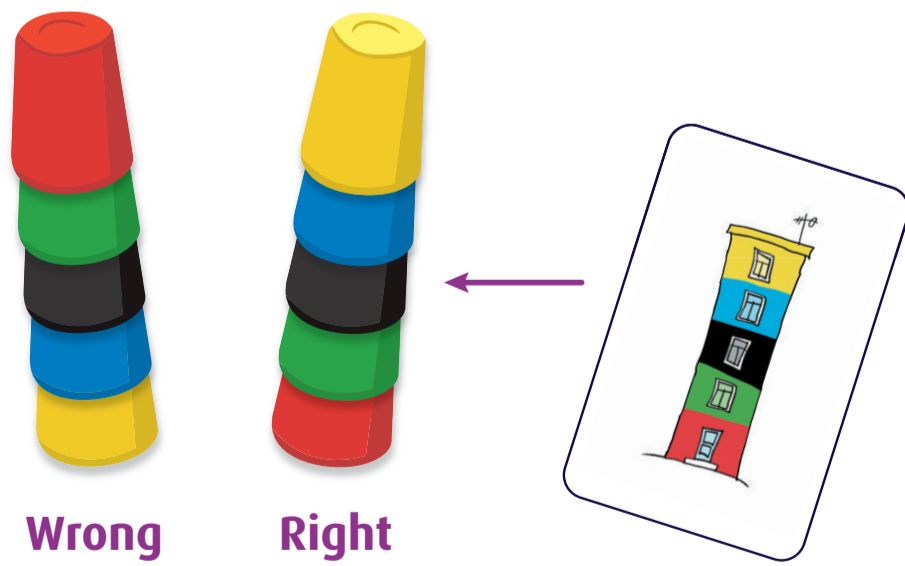


Getting Ready

- Place the bell in the center.
- Shuffle the cards and place the deck face down anywhere on the table.
- Give each participant a set of 5 Cups in 5 different colors.
- All players place their cups in front of them, one next to the other.

How to Play

- Turn over the top picture card.
- As soon as the picture is revealed, all the players quickly arrange their cups in the same sequence of colors as they appear in the picture card. Notice that some cards show a vertical sequence and some cards show horizontal sequence of colors. If a horizontal picture card appears, then the cups must be placed in a line one next to the other. If a vertical picture card is revealed, then the cups must be placed one on top of the other. (See example below).
- Every player who finishes arranging his cups must ring the bell.
- The first player who rings the bell wins the card only after his cups are checked to see if they match the card. If his arrangement was wrong then the player who rang the bell the second wins the card (if his cups are arranged correctly of course.). If he was wrong too, the card goes to the next player, etc.
- Next round:
- **Light version:** Before you start a new round set all the cups in a straight line (one next to the other.)
- **Advanced version:** For extra challenge and super fun, leave the cups in the configuration of the previous round as the starting position for the next round.
- After all 24 cards have been played, the game ends and the player with the most cards is the winner.



A few tips on how to become of Super Cup Master

- Think before you act.
- Keep your concentration up and do not act hysterically. It is the speed of the mind rather than the speed of your hands that will bring you victory.
- Try to use both hands.
